

Adverbs of Place Practice

Consider the sentences below. Then focus on filling in the blank with one of these place words:

derunder, derover/derovre, derved/dervede, derind/derinde, derop/deroppe, derud/derude
under there over there down there in there up there out there

Think about whether there is movement from one place to another (use a place word that does NOT end in -e) or whether the person is staying where they are (in which case, the word WILL end in -e)

Examples:

Jeg cykler til garagen og så cykler jeg derind.
Jeg reparerer mit cykeldæk derinde.

I bicycle to the garage and then I bike in there. (moving into)
I repair my bike tire in there. (staying put)

1) Han står derovre og snakker med Tine.

He is standing over there and talking with Tine.

2) Skal vi gå derover og danse?

Shall we walk over there and dance?

3) Katten sidder dervede.

The cat is sitting down there.

4) Tyven løb derind !

The thief ran in there!

5) Jeg bar alle kufferter derop.

I carried all of the luggage up there.

6) Hun gemmer skoene derunder.

She hides the shoes under there.

7) Preben læser en bog derinde på sofaen.

Preben is reading a book in there on the sofa.

8) Det regner derude, ikke?

It's raining out there, isn't it?

9) Spring derved !

Jump down there!

10) Babyen kravler ofte derud.

The baby often crawls out there.

11) Fuglene piper deroppe i trægrenene.

The birds are chirping up there in the tree branches.
