

Adverbs of Place Practice

Consider the sentences below. Then focus on filling in the blank with one of these place words:

derunder, derover/derovre, derved/dervede, derind/derinde, derop/deroppe, derud/derude
under there over there down there in there up there out there

Think about whether there is movement from one place to another (use a place word that does **NOT** end in -e) or whether the person is staying where they are (in which case, the word **WILL** end in -e)

Examples:

Jeg cykler til garagen og så cykler jeg derind.
Jeg reparerer mit cykeldæk derinde.

I bicycle to the garage and then I bike in there. (moving into)
I repair my bike tire in there. (staying put)
