- Han smilede i går. (*smile*)
He smiled yesterday.
- Jeg stod og lo i går. (*stå, le*)
I stood and laughed yesterday.
- Arbejdede I i en butik sidste år? (*arbejde*)
Worked you guys in a small shop last year?
Did you guys work in a small shop last year?
- De hinker (or hinkede), fordi de er børn! (*hinke*)
They hopped because they are children!

- Pigen sparkede bolden i fredags. (*sparke*)
The girl kicked the ball last Friday.
- Han drak æblejuice i morges. (*drikke*)
He drank apple juice this morning.
- Vi kyssede hinanden i går. (*kysse*)
We kissed each other yesterday.
- Hun gav mig et glas vin i aftes. (*give*)
She gave me a glass of wine last evening.
- Jeg elsker min mand. (*elske*)
I love my husband.
